Digging out a place to sleep at night has become a common sight. Often they find shelter in caves when no tarps are available. ⇨

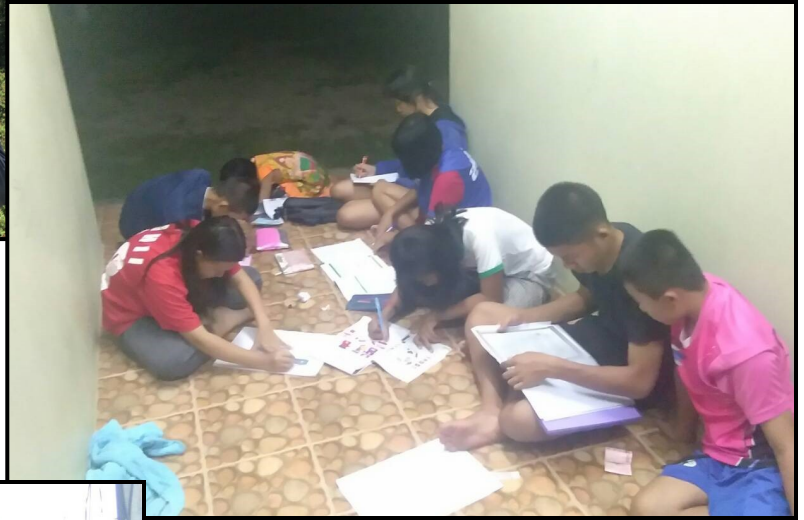


Berea Home . . . Latest Update
