May, our learning center coordinator for Grace Home, takes some of the girls out for some walking exercise. ⇨

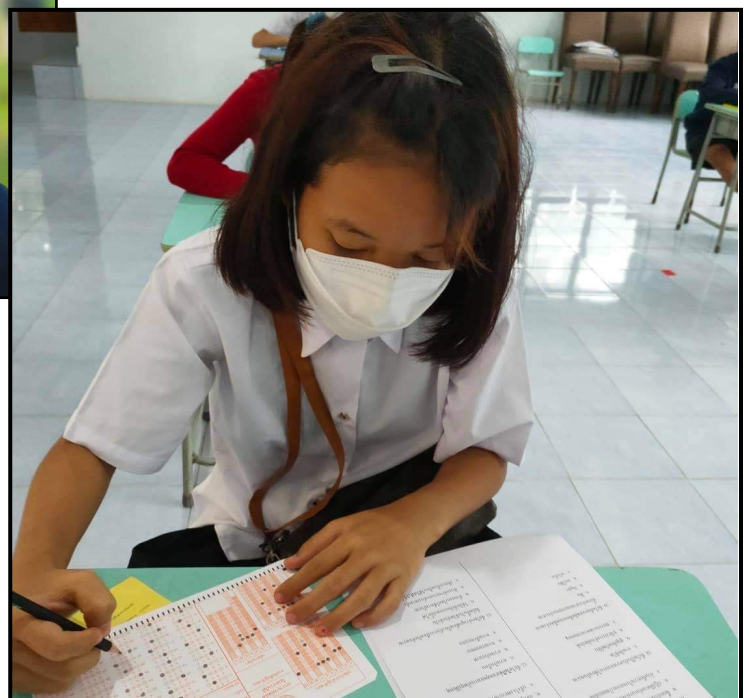


⇨ The girls all study hard working on their GED and they love to eat and get away from the classroom on Saturdays!
